G20 demonstrations, gang violence, gender disputes, gay pride, Tibetan rights, etc. We are constantly seeing groups demanding their civil liberties, marching for causes, creating disturbances with (and even murdering) those they disdain. Many of these incidents involve well-established groups and identities that have been around for ages, while others are constantly forming and changing. But beyond the media attention given to such visible intergroup events, each of us belongs to many social categories. In fact, some scholars claim a really significant proportion of our time is not interacting with other people based on their individual merits and personal qualities but, rather, on the kinds of groups we perceive them to belong to. This seminar explores these issues, and how we ourselves live our intergroup lives. We will study different kinds of data, their methodological strengths and limitations, and introduce new concepts, theories, and applications. Once familiar with these dynamics, we will focus on two intergroup settings which can be fraught with problems (and globally so): Intergenerational communication across the lifespan, and police-civilian encounters.
