

KIRBY-JONES SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Marvel Kirby and the late Robert Kirby, whose family has long-standing ties to UCSB, generously endowed scholarships in honor of their granddaughters for students in the College of Letters and Science Honors Program. Five \$4,000 scholarships will be awarded in spring 2009, which marks the tenth year of recognizing academic achievement and contributions to the campus and community.

Applicants must be students in the College of Letters and Science Honors Program who will have at least 84 units completed by the end of spring 2009 quarter. Applicants must have been residents of Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, Ventura, or Kern Counties for a majority of their lives and/or have graduated from a high school in one of these counties. Applicants must be registered full-time students during the entire 2009-2010 academic year. Selection criteria will include GPA, overall academic achievement, and involvement in campus and community activities in college. Some consideration will be given to financial need, which will be evaluated in consultation with the Office of Financial Aid; however, eligibility for financial is not a criterion for application. The recipients will be announced by the end of spring quarter.
