# Guidelines and Requirements

---

**In order to remain in the College Honors Program, students must do the following:**

1. Maintain an overall GPA of 3.50.
2. Complete a minimum of 6 honors-designated units each year. The words *course honors* appear on your transcript when you earn a B or higher in an honors course.

→ An annual eligibility review of all honors students' transcripts is conducted each summer.

**In order to complete the College Honors Program, and earn the Certificate of Academic Excellence at graduation, students must do the following:**

1. Complete a specified number of honors-designated courses.

**Students accepted into the honors program upon admission from high school** must complete 36 honors-designated units, 20 of which must be upper-division.

**Transfer students accepted into the honors program at the time of admission to UCSB** must complete 20 honors-designated units, all of which must be upper-division.

**Students accepted into the honors program by earning an overall UC GPA of 3.50 or higher** must complete 36 honors-designated units, 20 of which must be upper-division.

**Students who participate in UC EAP for a full academic year** must complete at least 28 honors units, of which 12 must be upper-division. UC EAP students who graduate within four years must complete 10 hours of community service during their last year.

**Students who enter UCSB as freshman and who graduate in three years** must complete at least 28 honors units, of which 20 must be upper-division, and 10 hours of community service.

2. Graduate with a 3.50 overall UC GPA.
3. Complete the service requirement.

Students must perform at least 10 hours of volunteer community service during each of their last two years of enrollment at UCSB. Students should turn in a Service Agreement form (available online or at 1117 Cheadle Hall) to verify the number of hours completed. We publicize service opportunities in binders in the honors study center and the College Office; at the Community Affairs Board (CAB), UCen 2523; and on the honors e-mail discussion list.

4. File a petition to **Complete the College Honors Program** to 1117 Cheadle during the first two weeks of the quarter in which you will graduate.
