**In order to complete the College Honors Program, and earn the Certificate of Academic Excellence at graduation, students must do the following:**

- 1. Complete a specified number of honors-designated courses.

Students accepted into the honors program upon admission from high school **must complete 36 honors-designated units, 20 of which must be upper-division.**

**Transfer students accepted into the honors program at the time of admission to UCSB** must complete 20 honors-designated units, all of which must be upper-division.

**Students accepted into the honors program by earning an overall UC GPA of 3.50 or higher** must complete 36 honors-designated units, 20 of which must be upper-division.

**Students who participate in UC EAP for a full academic year** must complete at least 28 honors units, of which 12 must be upper-division. UC EAP students who graduate within four years must complete 10 hours of community service during their last year.

**Students who enter UCSB as freshmen and who graduate in three years** must complete at least 28 honors units, of which 20 must be upper-division.

- 2. Graduate with a 3.50 overall UC GPA.

- 3. Complete the service requirement.

Students must perform at least 10 hours of volunteer community service during each of their last two years of enrollment at UCSB. Please turn in a Service Agreement form (available online or at 1117 Cheadle Hall) to verify the number of hours completed.

It will take up to three months after the end of your final quarter to prepare and send the certificate to the diploma address you provided to the office of registrar.
